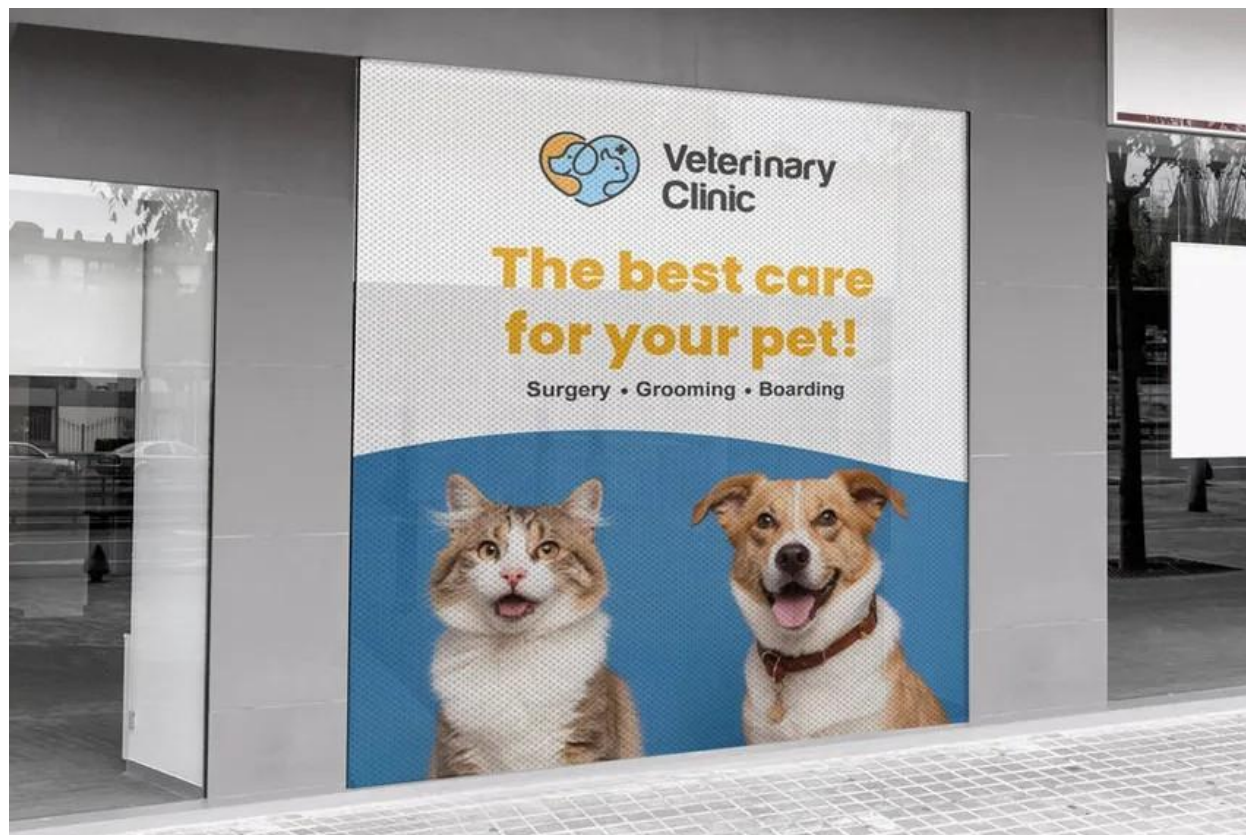

Materials and Printing for Perforated Window Decals



Custom perforated window graphics are made of vinyl rolls with small, evenly spaced holes across the material. The medium is utilized for all kinds of advertising and decorative purposes due to its sturdiness and versatility. Our perfs have a 70/30 opacity to perforation ratio. The frontside of the perforated window signs is white to reflect the sun, whereas the backside is black to allow the viewer to see through to the other side.

For graphics, we use a UV-curing system which dries the ink while applying content onto the front face of the perforated vinyl window decals. This process makes the colors fade-resistant, preserving their vividness for up to three years.

How to install a perforated window decal?

You can install perforated window signs only through a dry mounting technique. For a seamless and quick setup, follow the detailed steps.

How to clean perforated window graphics?

Get a soft towel, wet it lightly, and run it smoothly over the perforated window signs to clean them. Avoid using ammonia or acid-based cleaners as they may damage the ink.

Where to store the perforated window graphics?

Keep see-through graphics for windows at +70°F and 50% humidity to preserve the quality of the product. The storage life of perforated window decals is one year.

Installation Guide for Perforated Window Decals

Dry Mounting

This is the quickest and easiest method for the installation of these products. However, it's advisable to do the installation with assistance. It may be difficult to apply larger sizes alone and you won't be able to reposition the adhesive once it sticks to the surface.

Step 1: Wipe the surface clean using a damp cloth.

Step 2: Position the product on the window with the backing on and align it.

Step 3: Secure the product with tape on each side, marking the edges.

Step 4: Peel back 6 inches of backing and align the product with the marks on the window.

Step 5: Press the product onto the surface and use a squeegee to smooth from the center outward.

Step 6: Peel off the remaining backing and continue applying with the squeegee.
